### IMSA-Dr. V.V.Kulkarni Award on Animal Byproducts Utilization 2023 & 2024

#### Terms and Conditions

1. The name of the award will be **“IMSA-Dr. V.V.Kulkarni Award on Animal Byproducts Utilization**
2. The award shall be sponsored from the interest accrued from the fixed deposit of Rs. 50,000/- contributed by Dr.V.V.Kulkarni, Former Director, National Meat Research Institute, Hyderabad. The award will be conferred on selected candidates during the annual/biannual conference of the association.
3. Every year one award will be conferred during the annual IMSA Conference. In case if the event is held after 2 years, two awards will be given. The individual award will consist of a citation and a memento bearing the IMSA logo.
4. **Objectives of the Award**  
To recognize the **outstanding research/ developmental work in the area of animal byproducts and waste utilization/ disposal.**
5. **Eligibility**
  - a. Applicant must have a minimum experience of 15 years in the area of Meat Science.
  - b. Applicant must be a life member of Indian Meat Science Association (IMSA).
6. **Administration of the Award**  
There shall be a Judging Committee consisting of 2-3 expert members appointed by the President, IMSA. The judging committee will shortlist the applications (depending on the number of applications) for each year and recommend to EC of IMSA. After approval from President, IMSA the shortlisted candidates will be informed.
7. **Evaluation Criteria**  
The application will be evaluated on the basis of potential of the work (basic/applied) for advancing the existing knowledge/practical utility/novelty/quality.

## 8. Procedure

Applications for the award made in the prescribed application proforma may be downloaded from the IMSA web site ([www.imsa.org.in](http://www.imsa.org.in)). The duly filled proforma will be accepted on or before **31<sup>st</sup> July 2024**. Soft copy of the duly filled application along with relevant documents may be sent to **Secretary, IMSA, at [imsanrem@gmail.com](mailto:imsanrem@gmail.com)**.

No TA/DA will be provided to the applicants.

Note: The potential candidates from the industry may also apply for this award along with documentary evidence supporting their outstanding contribution in the area of animal byproducts and waste utilization. The experts will evaluate the same and will shortlist the suitable applicants. It is preferable that the industry personnel to be a member of society, not mandatory.
